

CURBAR, CALVER & FROGGATT JOINT BURIAL GROUND COMMITTEE

TABLE OF FEES

The fees, payments and sums set out below apply where the person is to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is, or immediately before their death was an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parishes of Curbar, Calver or Froggatt or, in the case of a still-born child, where the parents (or one of them) are, or at the time of internment were such inhabitants or parishioners.

In all other cases, the fees, payments and sums will be doubled.

PART 1 INTERNMENT

The fees indicated do not include the digging of the grave.

1. For any internment in a grave:
 - (i) Of the body of a still-born child, or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed one month. No Charge
 - (ii) Of the body of a child whose age at the time of death exceeded one month, but did not exceed 12 years. £80.00
 - (iii) Of the body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 12 years. £415
2. For the internment of cremated remains. £110

PART 2 MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, TABLETS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS.

For the right to erect or place on a grave:-

- (i) A headstone not exceeding 2ft 9 inches(83.5 cms) in height and width and not more than 3 inches (7.5cms) thick(which may include in the base the provision of a vase) £80
- (ii) A vase not exceeding 12 inches(30.5 cms) £15

The fees included for the various heads of this part include the first inscription. For each inscription after the first a fee of £10 will be charged.

PART 3 INSCRIPTIONS

- (i) The Christian name and surname of the deceased should be given, with age and date(or year of death), or the years of birth and death.
- (ii) Epitaph – the object of epitaphs is to “identify the resting place of the deceased, to honour the dead, to comfort the living, and to inform posterity” They should, therefore, be simple and relevant. Nick-names are not considered suitable and if a scripture text is used, it is necessary, to give the reference.
