498 **Traffic Management and Winter Maintenance**

- Following recent snowfall, Roads were ploughed and gritted where needed. The issue of icy roads was raised by a Councillor. Agreed to review the location of grit bins with DCC and take action to get mounds of grit delivered where necessary.
- There are 2 grit bins within the village which are owned by the Parish Council, the cost for DCC to refill these grit bins is £114.48 per bin. Agreed to research alternative options.
- A Councillor expressed concern regarding bricks and a pallet left on the side of the Road. This issue should be reported to Highways.

- Quote received for a new Digital CCTV camera to be installed, **resolved** to go ahead with installation.
